ATLANTIS MARINA BAHAMAS

A firm favourite of many YPI yacht owners, Atlantis Marina is essentially a luxury holiday island complex with an outstanding marina. It boasts a world-class casino, huge water park and one of the world's biggest aquariums and marine exhibits, with 14 lagoons and more than 50,000 aquatic animals representing over 250 marine species. One of their best-rated water slides shoots through a shark tank. It also offers a Tom Weiskopf-designed Ocean Club Golf Course and incredible free diving. The setting is absolutely stunning, surrounded as it is by beautiful beaches, and the marina village is always buzzing with cultural festivities. "We are also the most secure marina within this part of the world thanks to being land-locked, so we are especially popular during hurricane season," says Herbert Bain, vice president of marine operations. The 62 berths are beautifully maintained, there are fuel pumps, door-to-door transport and delivery services to and from the marina. Staff service is impeccable. Anything paid for at the marina or hotel can be charged to the boat (simply flash your marine card). "Most of our customers are repeat bookers. They see us as a home from home," says Bain.

PORTO MONTENEGRO MONTENEGRO

Set in the UNESCO-protected Bay of Kotor, Porto Montenegro is a relatively new superyacht destination. It was recently voted THYA Superyacht Marina of the Year 2015. This redeveloped Austro-Hungarian naval base has 450 berths, ranging from 12 metres (39ft 4in) to 180 metres (590ft 7in), and is spotless. No expense had been spared in its development, which is backed by some of the world's richest and most influential investors, including Canadian businessman Peter Munk. "They've created luxurious apartments around the edge, imported architects and builders from London, and brought palm trees in from Hawaii," says Peter Murray Kerr of Mooringspot.com. There are designer shops and a five-star hotel, Regent Porto Montenegro, with more planned, including One & Only, Four Seasons, Banyan Tree and Kempinski. Golf courses and a casino are also planned. There's a dedicated fuel dock at Jetty 3 with a stock of up to 800,000 litres of duty-free diesel. With a complimentary luxury lifestyle concierge and a multi-lingual marina team, it is quickly becoming a luxury haven in the Adriatic.

ONE OCEAN PORT VELL BARCELONA

With Spain now opening up to the world of superyachts thanks to the recent exemptions from the infamous Tax Matriculación, this is one marina definitely worth noting. Perfectly located on the doorstep of the old town, it is a natural deep water harbour built by the Romans and Phoenicians, and used throughout the centuries by the kings and queens of Spain. A recent

major redevelopment, thanks to £100 million of investment from Salamanca Group, has transformed it into a state-of-the-art superyacht destination for yachts up to 190m (623ft 4in) with 148 spacious berths which are designed to be wide enough to open side doors to get the tenders out. There is also a tender service and pick-up from the helipad opposite the marina, and the private members OneOcean Club "provides a fine dining gastronomic experience and international cocktail bar," says Regina Serrano, marketing and communications executive at Marina Port Vell. "The Gallery is the ultimate business hub with over 10 international superyacht businesses, a dedicated crew lounge, gymnasium and OneOcean wellness centre."

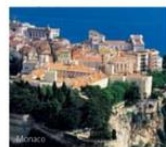


MONACO FRENCH RIVIERA

Mixing old school elegance with modern business sense, Monaco is ensuring it remains at the top of its game. The Government of Monaco identified yachting as one of their key growth sectors and as such they are doing all they can to make themselves a haven for yacht owners and captains alike. From the Monaco Yachting Cluster, a think tank dedicated to improving yachting in the area, to the planned artificial island set to provide even greater berthing capacity, Monaco is constantly innovating.

Innovation, though, is still surpassed here by the sheer glamour of the resort.
